Ask a First Grader:

- How have you changed since you were born?
- How have you changed since the beginning of the school year?
- How do you say "to roll" in Spanish? (rodar)

Reading/Writing

- We've started conjugating verbs. For example the word "play" in "I play" changes when you say "You play" or "They play" etc.
- So far we've learned the verb "jugar" = play and "tener" = to have.
- The first graders have learned how to read the morning message every day. So we threw in a new twist. Now they have to figure out what the missing letters are. We are starting with beginning letter sounds.

This week in First Grade...

- Today I sent home the math test. I don't have the English translation, so *do the best you can* to work with your child to **correct the test and return it by next week.**
- We began an IB Unit of Inquiry called "Changes Through Place and Time." We will be learning about how we change, how cultures have changed, and how technology has changed.
- We continued our explorations of movement: how things roll!
- In the spring we'll have a fun unit on INSECTS!
