FUN IN THE SUN

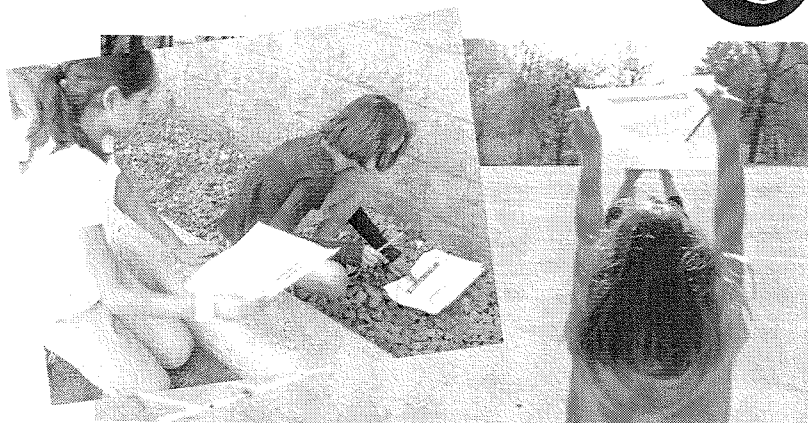


IB Unit:

Solar Energy:

Students did an experiment where they had to compare the temperature measures after having a thermometer for 5 minutes in the sun and then 5 minutes in the shade. After that they had to create a graph showing the changes in the two cases. Students have learned that the sun

has a very quick effect on the temperature of things. They also learned to transfer temperatures between Celsius and Fahrenheit degrees.

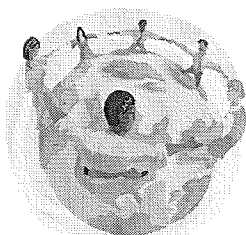

6th graders are learning how to work with equations and number sentences.

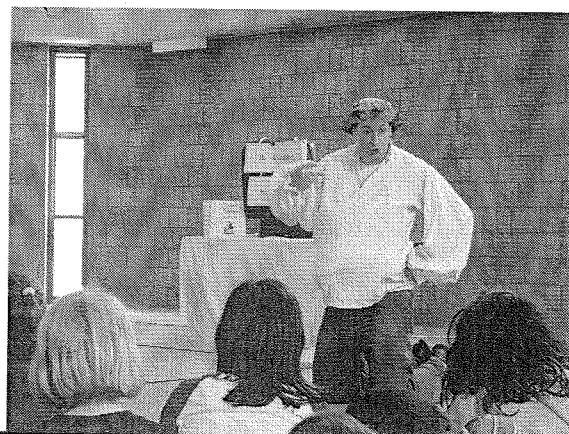
ALL ABOUT ISLA:
