Unit of Inquiry:

Our mapping unit of inquiry is going great so far! We have received about 15 postcards already! The furthest have come from Alaska. We are marking each one on the map with a sticker. It has been lots of fun so far. We have been learning about all the components that maps include and the different types of maps. The students have also come up with different questions we will answer based on the IB concept questions. After learning more about the different kinds of maps, students will create their own maps.

Family Night:

Math:

The students have been learning many new math concepts. They started practicing multiplication problems by drawing a matrix to solve the problems. For example, if a problem is 3 X 4 they draw a rectangle with 3 lines of 4 dots. Ask your child to explain this to you. Also, we have started some division. To do these problems, the students take a number of items and distribute them equally among a number of circles. So, to solve 24 divided by 6, they draw 6 circles and count out 24 putting one in each circle. What exciting concepts for 2nd graders to be learning!
