Lectura / Reading ~



- We read the book "Jorge el Curioso Siembra una Semilla" (Curious George Plants a Seed). This book fits perfectly with our I.B. theme for March which is *curiosity (curiosidad)*.
- We also read "Pequeño Coala Busca Casa" on Tuesday. Little Koala wants to find a place to have breakfast in the tree with his mommy, but no one in the tree will share their branch. They find the best branch in the tree at the top by the end of the book, and decide to share their breakfast with the other not-so-nice friends in the tree.
- Students have been doing very well on learning and pronouncing their sight words. We will probably start Book-in-a-Bag a little early this year, since a lot of students are hungry for more reading and appear ready.



Ciencias / Science

- On Thursday we played a game with a "Feely Box." This box is a Mystery Box that students got to use to try to match a piece of fabric outside the box with one they could not see inside the box. There were ten different types of fabric in all for different students to compare. Students had to touch, smell, and observe the different fabrics outside the box before making their decision with what they felt inside.
