Lectura / Reading ~



- We read "Todos los Colores de la Tierra" (All the colors of the world) which is a book written and illustrated by kindergartners in Oregon. This is a great book that shows how people who are different from one another can celebrate their diversity and be friends.
- The **Book-in-a-Bag** project is going well! Students are getting practice reading new books each week and decoding faster and faster, in order to generate more fluency to prepare them for first grade next year. Students are using different strategies to read the new words they see, and their partners are also there to scaffold them should they need extra help.



Ciencias / Science

- Srta. Mariana read the book "Animales de 2 en 2" (Animals 2 by 2). This large book came with the FOSS Science Kit and is an excellent way to see similarities and differences among different types of animals. Students then got to **observe all three goldfish** on different tables, and **write** about what they saw in their **new fish journals**. Students drew the part of the fish they observed and wrote a sentence about that part of the fish in their new journals.
