Lectura / Reading ~

- We read a book about families and learned about how many families in the world are different, and many people have different features about them and their family that make them special and beautiful in their own unique way.
- On Friday, we read a book called "The Legend of the Poinsettia". We then got to make poinsettias out of red construction paper and bring them home to share with family for the holidays! ☺

Matemáticas / Math

- We played some number recognition games like "Baile de Numeros" (Dance of Numbers) and "Mata Mosca" (Fly Swatter) which were fun ways of practicing numbers we're learning how to recognize.
- We cut out number cards from our math books and played number games to learn number recognition, ordering, counting, and one-to-one correspondence.
- We also played a game with connecting cubes and dice that was like playing with a train. The first day students rolled a die and had to connect that many cubes, and the next day they started out with the whole train and rolled the die to see how many to take away. This game helped set the foundation for addition and subtraction.
