Silabas/Syllables and Sight Words

This week we discussed the first five including: ella, él, por, para and una. You can assist your student to learn sight words in English by conducting echo readings with their favorite story. Someone reads a phrase while tracing under the words with their finger and have the child mimic the action. If it's their favorite book, it should not be boring for them. ☺
