### Sonidos Iniciales/Initial Sounds

This week we began to dive into a book the children will learn how to read and illustrate themselves. We read the título/title together and began to recognize the sentences/frases. By the end of the week students will know how sentences/frases end with a period/punto. While you read with your student ask them to identify one or all of these three things.

### Matemáticas/Mathematics
