Sonidos Iniciales/Initial Sounds

I can tell everyone was working hard over break to learn the sonidos because students demonstrated this during their individual assessments this week and last. We continue our work on illustrating our story *Mamá, Papá y Ana*. This story also gives students more exposure to the syllables with “a,” which after the sonidos is the next phase in their individual assessments.

Matemáticas/Mathematics

For the past two days the students have been working on simple addition and subtraction problems using a small bag/bosillo. Ask your student to show you how it works: After each addition or subtraction of a known number objects we ask, ¿Cuántos están en el bosillo?/How many are in the pocket?
