Sonidos Iniciales/Initial Sounds

As the students progress through the sounds in Spanish, we continue to work on the next challenge of the syllables. In our daily routine we choose a syllable with “a” to sing the last part of the Hola song at the beginning of our day. We will begin to move on to sing the syllables with “e, i, o and u.” We will shift our daily practice to more syllable work as more and more students finish their testing with sonidos.

Matemáticas/Mathematics

At the end of last week and through this week we learned a new song to help us count by tens in Spanish. While we sing we use our fingers to count by tens up to 100. You can ask your student about the song, they love to sing the end: Cien, cien, cien muy bien. (Repeat) They might need help with the beginning: Diez, veinte, tre, tre, tre, treinta, etc.
