Silabas/Syllables

We have begun our dive into the sight words that kindergarteners should know by the end of the year. Yesterday we discussed the first five including: en, el, la, los and las. Each week we hope to add five more sight words to our word wall. You can practice at home by practicing writing the words in different colors, finding the letters in magazines to glue together on a separate piece of paper. We continue to practice the syllables; we have just added a new dimension to our literacy practice.

Matemáticas/Mathematics

Today we will work with the symbol (-) or *menos*. We will practice simple subtraction using our math manipulatives and saying the whole equation aloud. For example, *sies menos tres son tres* or $6 - 3 = 3$. This week we formed different shapes with our bodies lying down on the floor in small groups. It was interesting to see them working together to tackle their shape. Ask your student what shape they made and what part they were in the shape.

Música/Music

Today the students will begin their music classes with Señor Gonzáles in preparation for the Kinder Spring Concert, (date TBA) which will be held separate from the Spring Concert with the rest of the school, on account of the number of students in kindergarten this year. We are very excited that Señor Gonzáles is willing to help us get ready by donating his time to our class on Thursdays. We will practice our music during regular class time as well throughout the week. Ask your student about music class and if they followed the essential agreements we made as a class in order to have this privilege.
