### Sílabas/Syllables and Sight Words

This week we discussed another five sight words including: donde, ¿Dónde?, cual, ¿Cuál?, and quiero. We are almost at the end of our cincuenta/fifty odd sight words for kinder. We will start in on the list of high frequency words in Spanish. Also we've been practicing spelling words by listening to the sounds within the word, gaining even more practice with syllables and sounds.
